NOTICE INVITING TENDER

Notice Inviting Tender No. 11/NORTH BENGAL WILD ANIMALS PARK /2022-23 of The Director, North Bengal Wild Animals Park, Siliguri invites tender in sealed applications from reputed and experienced agency/firm/company etc having entitlement for similar nature of works at NBWAP, Siliguri.

SUBMISSION OF BID THROUGH OFFLINE.

The eligible and interested agency/firm/company etc may collect the tender form/ application from office of the Director, North Bengal Wild Animals Park, Siliguri by paying non-refundable fees of Rs. 1,000/- (Rupees One Thousand only) for each project by way of Demand Draft/Cheque favoring Director, NBWAP, Siliguri

The documents submitted without the prescribed fee shall be rejected. The duly filled in application in prescribed format along with all supporting documents as well as Earnest Money in the form of Demand Draft in favour of Director, NBWAP, Siliguri shall be sealed in a cover and submitted to the office of the Director, NBWAP, Siliguri as per the time schedule given below.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

- 1) A Tenderer is to quote rates in figures as well as in words at percentage above, below or as per the rates shown in the specification schedule of works for the project. The particulars of works may be enquired from the office of the Director, NBWAP, Siliguri.
- 2) Respective earnest money (Bid Security) as mentioned against each project should be deposited in the form of Bank Draft or any instrument in any nationalized bank pledged to Director, NBWAP, Siliguri and the original challan/instrument must be attached with the tender failing which the tender shall be summarily rejected.
- 3) The rate quoted must be written legibly in English and any correction must be initialed by the tenderer. No tender with erasing or overwriting will be accepted.
- 4) No conditional rate will be considered. The Estimated amount is inclusive of all taxes.
- 5) The rate quoted has to be FOR DESTINATION.
- 6) The works shown in the tender schedule will be taken up only on availability of fund and Govt. Sanction. The undersigned does not guarantee of taking up of any or all works and no compensation will be payable to the tenderer for work in question, if not taken up due to any reason whatsoever.
- 7) The tender will be opened by the Director, NBWAP, Siliguri or his representative at the place and time as notified in the tender notice as well as in office notice board.
- 8) The final acceptance of the tender is subject to the approval of the Director, NBWAP, Siliguri.
- 9) The Director, NBWAP, Siliguri can accept any tender either wholly or for one or more ingredients only.
- 10) The successful tenderer shall have to execute an Agreement of contract before issuance of work/supply order.

- 11) Quoting merely the lowest price does not confer any right to any bidder for award of work order. The NBWAP reserves the right to select any bid on the grounds of quality, offer of additional/special features, compatibility etc.
- 12) The NBWAP also reserves the right to reject any bids with sub-standard products even if they are found to be lowest

13) Eligibility criteria for participation in the tender :

- a. The prospective tenders as a primary bonafide, resourceful contractor/Firm/organization/ Agencies having entitlement for supply works and having credential for similar nature work of value not less than 40% of the amount put to the tender under the state Government or its undertaking or the Central Government or its undertaking or any Statutory Body constituted under the stature of Central/State Govt. during the last 3 (Three) years from the date of issue of the Notice.

OR

Two completed work of similar nature of value not less than 30% of the amount put to the tender under the state Government or its undertaking or the Central Government or its undertaking or any Statutory Body constituted under the stature of Central/State Govt. during the last 3 (Three) years from the date of issue of the Notice.

- b. All prospective tenderer shall submit valid Income Tax Acknowledgement Receipt for the latest Assessment year, P.T. Deposit Challan for the latest Assessment year, PAN Card, GST Registration Certificate, Trade license (valid).
- c. Joint venture will not be accepted.
- d. All prospective tenderer shall be allowed to participate in the work either in the capacity of individual or as a partner of a firm. If the prospective tenderer is found to have applied severally in a single work, all his application for that work will be rejected.
- e. All prospective tenderer shall be allowed to participate in one or more than one of the above mentioned works in this notice.
- f. No conditional/ incomplete tenders will be accepted under any circumstances.
- g. It shall be the responsibility on each bidder to fully inform /acquaint / familiarize itself with local conditions and factors, which may have any effect on the execution of services to be rendered under the contract. All bidder (s) intending to bid shall visit and make themselves thoroughly acquainted with the local site conditions.
- h. NBWAP shall presume that the bidder has understood and agreed that all the relevant factors have been kept in view while submitting the bid. No financial adjustment arising thereof shall be permitted by NBWAP, on the basis of any non- clarity of information about local conditions being pleaded by the bidder.
- i. Further, no claim for financial adjustment being made by the contract awarded on this tender document will be entertained by NBWAP.

14) Financial Bid

- a) The price bid must be filled in completely, without any error, erasures or alterations as per the specified format given in Annexure-II.
- b) The price should be mentioned in Indian Rupees only in clearly readable format without any overwriting.

- c) The financial bid shall be on a fixed price basis, no price variation on any account shall be considered.
- d) Price quotation accompanied by vague and conditional expression such as "subject to immediate acceptance, "subject to confirmation before sales etc. will be treated as being at variance and shall be liable for rejection.
- e) The envelope consisting of financial offer shall be marked as "Tender for supply & installation of Projector with Telescope and Red Dot Mount at NBWAP, Siliguri." along with Bidder name address.
- f) The responsibility of the Bidder items in this Tender Document and submit the total cost in the financial bid.
- g) The quoted rates should be including all direct & indirect taxes as well as insurance, packing & forwarding, transportation and installation along with all the incidental & customization charges if any. The park authority will not liable for pay to any others charges except quoted rates.
- h) The bidder shall ensure that there is no discrepancy in the rates mentioned in figures and words. In case of any discrepancy, the unit rate mentioned in the words shall be taken as final and binding
- i) In the event of arithmetic calculation mistake, the individual price in words shall be considered for calculation.
- j) The bidder must fill and submit the rates as per instructions given above

15) Security deposit-

EMD submitted by successful bidder shall be converted as part of the security deposit. Remaining part of the Security Deposit of the accepted tender value will be adjusted from the bill of the contractor. No interest will be paid on Security Deposit (SD) by the authority.

a) Additional Performance Security (APS) - As per Finance Deptt. Govt of West Bengal order no 4608-F(Y) dated 18.07.2018 , If the bid value becomes 80% or less of the estimated value put to tender, APS shall have to be submitted @ 10 % of the tendered amount in the form of Bank Guarantee from any scheduled bank in favor of Director, NBWAP, Siliguri before issuance of the work/supply order. If the bidder fails to submit the APS within seven days, his earnest money shall be forfeited. The bank guarantee shall have to be valid upto end of contract period and shall be renewed if required.

b) This security deposit will be released to the contractor after twelve (12) months from the last date of completion of work for the project, if no defect is noticed within this period. In case of any defect, the security deposit will be forfeited, in addition to any legal action as deemed fit & required.

c) No interest will be paid on security deposit.

16) Tenderers may inspect the site of the supply works will be done.

17) All the Supply is to be carried out according to the specification of ANNEXURE-II or Supply subject to the modification if any made by the undersigned or his authorized representative.

- 18) The undersigned reserves the right to increase or decrease the volume of any item or works to the extent of 25% and to add new item of works or withdraw any items of works at his discretion at any stage of the execution of the works.
- 19) No running payment will be made in respect of the said work.
- 20) No mobilization/secured advance will be allowed.
- 21) The delivery and installation should be completed within **30 days** from the date of receipt of the LOA. The Director and his authorized representative shall have the right to inspect the goods prior to dispatch at suppliers premises or after installation at sites before release of payment.
- 22) The delivery and installation should be completed within **30 days** from the date of receipt of the LOA. The Director and his authorized representative shall have the right to inspect the goods prior to dispatch at suppliers premises or after installation at sites before release of payment..
- 23) The earnest money of all unsuccessful bidders/agencies will be released only on receipt of application but not before issuance of work order to successful (L1) bidder and on completion of execution of an agreement.
- 24) The contractor shall have no claim to any payment before the completion of work and part payment will only be made in actual measurement of the completed works (in conformity with the plan specification and estimates) at the discretion of the undersigned after deduction of outstanding amount, if any.
- 25) The undersigned reserves the right to cancel the contracts on ground of unsatisfactory or delayed work and failure to fulfill terms and conditions of the contract and thereby forfeit the security deposit under the terms of the agreement.
- 26) If any detailed specification of any work or material or the rate of any work item has not been quoted anywhere, it shall be taken to the same as that mentioned in the appropriate schedule of PWD as applicable for the Jalpaiguri District.
- 27) The labour rates should be paid on the basis of relevant orders of Labour Deptt. Govt. of West Bengal. The labourers employed shall not be a liability of the Park and shall have no claim being in direct employment of the Park.
- 28) Labour welfare cess @ 1 % (One percent) will be deducted from every bill of the contractor in pursuance of G.O no 599A/4M-28/06 dated 27.09.2006
- 29) Deduction of Tax shall be made as per the provisions of WB state GST as applicable.
- 30) Deduction of Sales Tax where ever applicable shall be made as per the provisions of Commercial tax rules in vogue from every bill of the contractor

- 31) Neither the contract nor any rights granted under the contract may be sold, leased/sublet, assigned ,or otherwise transferred, in whole or in part, by the vender, and any such attempted sale, lease, assignment or otherwise transfer shall be void and of no effect. The vender shall not subcontract or permit anyone other than its personnel to perform any of the work, service or other performance required of the vender under the contract.
- 32) The successful tenderer shall be liable for any injury caused to the worker(s) or death of worker (s) engaged by him during the execution of the work and all safety measures shall have to be taken by the contractor as per the provisions of the building and other construction workers' (Regulation of employment and condition of service) Act 1996. NBWAP under WBZA shall not be responsible for any such injury /death/accident or for any situation arising out of unfortunate incidents.
- 33) In connection with the work, Arbitration will not be allowed. Sub-letting of contract is also strictly prohibited. The successful tenderer may however authorize representative for the following reasons-
- a) To supervise day to day management of works.
 - b) To attend the measurement when taken by the officers of the NBWAP and sign the records of such measurement.
 - c) To submit the requisition of materials if any.
 - d) The selection of the authorized representatives is subject to the prior approval from the undersigned. Successful tenderer shall inform the undersigned in writing the name and address of the representatives he wants to appoint and the specific purpose which the representative will be authorized for.
 - e) Any notice correspondence etc issued to such authorized representative or left at his address will be deemed to have been issued to the successful tenderer himself. The successful tenderer shall be held responsible for all action of his authorized representative and his workmen who must abide by the Rules and regulations in force and any offence committed by them will be dealt with the relevant acts & rules.
- 34) The Tender shall remain valid for a period of **90 days** after last date as specified in the tender.
- 35) The bidder should clearly read and understand all the terms and conditions, specifications, etc. mentioned in the original tender documents.
- 36) The successful tenderer shall comply with the provisions of a) the labour contract (Regulation and abolition act) 1970 b) the apprentice act 1961 c) the minimum wages act 1948.
- 37) It shall be the responsibility of the successful contractor to protect the materials to be used for construction or implements/machines against any theft and he shall have no right to claim for the loss through theft.
- 38) No bidder is permitted to canvass to NBWAP on any matter relating to this tender. Any bidder found doing so may be disqualified and bid may be rejected.
- 39) Director, NBWAP reserves the right to accept, split, divide, negotiate, cancel, or reject any bid or to annul and reject all bids at any time prior to the award of the contract without incurring any liability to the affected bidders or any obligation to inform affected bidder, the grounds of such action.

- 40) The bidder shall not make any addition or alternation in the tender documents. The requisite details should be filled in by the bidder wherever required in the documents. Incomplete tender or tender not submitted as per instructions is liable to be rejected.
- 41) The bidder must obtain for itself on its own responsibility and its own cost all the information including risks, contingencies & other circumstances in execution of the installation and commissioning. It shall also carefully read and understand all its obligations & liabilities given in tender documents.
- 42) Bidders may carefully note that they are liable to be disqualified at any time during bidding process in case any of the information furnished by them is not found to be true. The decision of NBWAP in this respect shall be final and binding.
- 43) Response submitted by the Bidder shall become the property of NBWAP and it (NBWAP) shall have no obligation to return the same to the Bidder.
- 44) If the Bidder conceals any material information or makes a wrong statement or misrepresents facts or makes a misleading statement in its response to Tender Document, in any manner whatsoever, NBWAP reserves the right to reject such response to Tender Document and cancel the Letter of Acceptance, if issued. Bidder shall be solely responsible for disqualification based on their declaration in the submission of response to Tender Document.
- 45) Wherever information has been sought in specified formats, the Bidders shall fill in the details as per the prescribed formats and shall refrain from any deviations and referring to any other document for providing any information required in the prescribed format.
- 46) This contract will include 1 year warranty on applicable items and maintenance and support from date of installation. It will also include service for parts and free telephonic support 24 X7).
- 47) On successful completion of the work and handing over of the systems in perfect working condition with demonstration to NBWAP, a Certificate of Completion shall be issued by NBWAP.
- 48) **Format for Bid submission:** The following formats are required to be submitted as part of the Tender Document. These formats are designed to demonstrate the Bidder's compliance with the Qualification Requirements set forth and other submission requirements specified in the Tender Document.
- a. Tender Application Form (**Annexure-I**)
 - b. Format for Financial Bid (**Annexure-II**)
- 49) **Validity of Tender:** The Tender shall remain valid for a period of 90 days from the last date for submission of tender as specified in the tender.
- 50) **Service Response for selected Bidder:** During warranty/maintenance period, time & mode of service response should be following.
- 51) For complaints not requiring spare parts, the system will be made operational within one working day or two calendar days, whichever is earlier, from the day of registration of complaint.

- 52) For complaints requiring spare parts, system will be made operational within five working days or seven calendar days, whichever is earlier, from the day of registration of complaint.
- 53) Notwithstanding the above, the Director reserves the right to accept or reject any bids and to cancel the bidding process and reject all bids at any time prior to the issue of Purchase Order.
- 54) Director, NBWAP reserves the right to reject any or all the responses to Tender Document or cancel the Tender Document without assigning any reasons whatsoever and without any liability.
- 55) **Cancellation of Contract:** Director, NBWAP reserves the right to cancel the contract of the selected bidder to whom LOA issued and recover expenditure incurred by NBWAP on the following circumstances.
- a. The bidder has made misleading or false representations in the forms, statements, and attachments submitted in proof of the eligibility requirements.
 - b. The selected bidder commits a breach of any of the terms and conditions of the bid/contract.
 - c. In case of liquidation voluntarily or otherwise during the execution of contract.
 - d. The progress regarding execution of the contract, made by the selected bidder is found to be unsatisfactory.
 - e. After the award of the contract, if the selected bidder fails to execute the order as per the term & conditions of LOA & Contract satisfactorily, NBWAP reserves the right to cancel the contract by forfeiting Performance Security as the case may be and blacklist the selected bidder for three years. This clause is applicable, if for any reason of firm's failure, the contract is cancelled.
- 56) The Letter of Acceptance (LOA) will be issued to the lowest responsive bidder whose bid will be selected by the Bid evaluation committee prior to expiry of the bid validity period. The terms of the accepted offer shall be incorporated in the purchase order.
- 57) **Award of Contract:** - Director, NBWAP shall issue LOA (Letter of Acceptance) or work order to the successful bidder in writing by a Registered Letter Courier/Speed Post or per bearer Issuance of LOA against an offer made shall constitute a legal and bonding contract between NBWAP and the selected bidder.
- 58) Payment will be made within 45 days after completion of delivery 9x9pt 10% for Performance Security Tender for supply & installation of Projector with Telescope and Red Dot Mount, NBWAP, Siliguri as per specifications Annexure- II) at site in good condition subject to satisfactory testing report from Veterinary Section of NBWAP The item along with accessories should be brought in sealed packing Damaged defected articles will not be accepted.
- 59) The Bids are liable to be rejected if any of the above conditions are not complied with
- 60) Any effort by a bidder to influence the Director in its decision on bid evaluation or placement of purchase order may result in rejection of the bidder's offer.

- 61) For any typographical mistake in case of Unit, Rate, Quantity, Amount, any type of nomenclature in items of works / item itself including description etc. whatsoever as stated in documents, contractor shall have no right to claim for the loss owing to misunderstanding due to such errors once the agreement is signed.
- 62) Work order will be issued subject to approval of fund from higher Authority and its availability.
- 63) The work must be completed within stipulated time frame and as per instruction of the park authority in this respect.
- 64) This tender notice along with all condition mentioned herein before shall also form a part of the agreement to be executed by such tenderer for the project.

General Rules and Instructions to the intending applicants

1. The details of the applicants and their experience shall be furnished in the prescribed "Application Format" only. Wherever required and if the space provides is not sufficient, particulars can be furnished in Annexure but such details shall be clearly be mentioned in the respective columns of the Application Format. Applicant shall enclose latest copies of brochures and technical documentation giving additional information about the applicant. Each page of the document shall be dully signed by the Applicant or their authorized representative.
2. No costs incurred by the applicant in applying and in providing necessary clarifications or attending discussions conferences or site visits will be reimbursed by the Park.
3. Documentary proof with respect to the pre-qualification criteria shall be furnished along with the application form. In this regard, copies of the work orders and completion certificates and or such other document shall be submitted. Incomplete applications or application without proper proofs for establishing their credentials will be liable for rejection and no correspondence will be entertained in this regard. The Proof of having successfully completed single work of value not less than 40 % of the estimated cost OR two(2) nos of works each of value not less than 30 % of the estimated cost need to be furnished.
4. Applications received after the due date or without EMD are liable for rejections.
5. Design may change as per CZA/WBZA guidelines and agencies have to modify accordingly without extra payment.
6. Site of work and necessary work testing may be handed over to the agency phase wise. No claim in this regard will be entertained.

7. The earnest money of all unsuccessful bidders/agencies will be released only on receipt of application but not before issuance of work order to successful (L1) bidder and on completion of execution of an agreement in this respect.
8. The Director, NORTH BENGAL WILD ANIMALS PARK, Siliguri , Government of West Bengal reserves the right to cancel the NIT due to unavoidable circumstances and no claim in this respect will be entertained.
9. Before issuance of the WORK ORDER, the tender inviting authority will verify the credential and other documents of the lowest tenderer if found necessary. On verification, if it is found that the documents submitted by the lowest tenderer is either manufactured or false, in that case work order will not be issued in favour of the said tenderer under any circumstances.
10. The payment for the works will be made by the Director, NBWAP after fulfillment of the necessary official formalities and detailed checking by authorized representative of the office of Director, NBWAP, Siliguri.
11. The successful agency/firm/company will have to make an agreement on terms and conditions of the contract on a Rs. 100/- non judicial stamp paper, the cost of which will be borne by the contracting agency/firm/company. In the event of failure to execute formal tender agreement within the allotted time the agency/firm/company will be liable for punishment and deposited Earnest Money will be forfeited & he will be debarred from participating in any Tender Works by the Director, NBWAP.
